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**SRI PADMAVATI MAHILA VISVAVIDYALAYAM- A BRIEF PROFILE**

Sri Padmavati Mahila Visva Vidyalayam, a women's university established by an act of Andhra Pradesh State of Legislature in 1983 with a mission of empowering women through education. The university is recognized by University Grants Commission under section 12 (B) of UGC act 1956. The University is empowered to award degrees/ diplomas specified by the UGC/AICTE/PCI/NCI/BCI/NCTE/RCI/ and other governing bodies in India.

Employability and entrepreneurship, pursuit of higher knowledge and integrated development of students are major facets in the design and development of the academic programmes. SPMVV has attained excellent reputation for blending contemporary education, pedagogies and technologies. The curriculum of various courses are designed and implemented by taking cognizance of the global needs while serving the cause towards national development and regional requirements.

The University is open to student and faculty exchange programmes. In practice faculty exchange under commonwealth, Marie Curie. BOYCAST, CREST, Fulbright, AP-Netherland, British Council exchange are promoted by the university by providing support and duty leave. Many faculty members have taken individual research projects, publications and conferences with faculty of different nations. In the process of internationalization the university has established a office of International Relations in January 2016, under which an International Desk and an International Student Cell are established to monitor the admission of International women students.

## ***OFFICE OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS***

The Dean and Associate Dean, International relations of SPMVV

- Monitor the admission of International women students and co-ordinate with the Directorate of admission
- Organize student Exchange programmes by entering into MOU with foreign Universities.
- Collaborate with foreign universities to offer integrated Graduate and Post Graduate programmes with Placement/ Training of students in foreign universities.
- Organize Twin/Duel/Integrated Graduate and Post Graduate programmes in collaboration with foreign universities.
- Organizes training programmes for Indian and International students in foreign languages –English, Chinese, Japanese, French, and German etc.

The Dean, International Relations networks with foreign universities, International Institutions, Embassies and Consulates of other countries and Association of Indian Universities. The office of the International Relations has two sections; International Students Desk and International Student Cell. The International Student Desk provides information on opportunities for students in foreign universities for apprenticeship, short courses, training programmes and research collaborations using the International linkages of SPMVV. The International Students Cell attends to admission of International students (Foreign and Non resident Indians) and addresses the issues related to International students.

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSIONS

### 1. Eligibility for International women students into various courses

#### Under Graduate courses:

The women candidates, who have qualified in 10+ 2 years of formal education or its equivalent examination recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are eligible for admission into relevant Under Graduate/ Bachelor's Degree programme offered by SPMVV on or off campus. The entry is through Common Entrance Tests (CET) conducted by the state of Andhra Pradesh for Bachelor Degree courses like Bachelor of Law, Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Special Education, Bachelor of Physical Education, Bachelor of Technology, Bachelor of Pharmacy, and Bachelor of Nursing.

**The international students are exempted from all forms of Entrance Tests for getting admission into various courses.**

#### Eligibility for admission into Post Graduate courses:

The International women students who have obtained their Bachelor's degree in any country in the concerned or allied subject(s) or its equivalent recognized by **Association of Indian Universities** are eligible for admission into the Post Graduate Courses directly with/ without a common Entrance Test conducted either by State\* or University\*\* in Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam.

\*For the courses like Masters in Computer Applications, Masters in Business Management the entry is through Common Entrance Tests (CET) conducted by the state of Andhra Pradesh.

\*\*For all other Post Graduate programmes the entry is through SPMVV PG CET- an entrance test conducted by SPMVV.

**The international students are exempted from all forms of Entrance Tests for getting admission into various courses.**

### **Eligibility for admission into MPhil/ Ph.D. programmes:**

The women candidates should have passed Masters Degree examination in the concerned subject (with 50 percent marks for Social Sciences and Humanities and 55 percent marks for Sciences or obtained equivalent Grades) or its equivalent recognized by Association of Indian Universities.

Only those students who have qualified from foreign Universities or Boards of Higher Education, recognized as equivalent by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are eligible for admission. When required, reference will be made to AIU to check the equivalence.

### **Eligibility for admission into Certificate/ Diploma programmes:**

The University has designed/ proposes to design Certificate (3 months) and Diploma (6 months) courses to suit the needs of Foreign and Non Resident Indians in the fields of Music, Yoga, Meditation, Spirituality, Food and Nutrition, Family Studies, Child Development, Social Work, Telugu, Mathematics, Education etc... Eligibility for these courses is Ten years of formal school education and English proficiency.

A single window system is provided and facilitated by Dean, International Relations for admission of International women students into various courses.

### **II. Step wise procedure of admission for International students:**

The admission of International students is done in two stages Viz., 1). Provisional Admission; 2). Final Admission.

- **Provisional Admission:** International students can apply for provisional admission into the undergraduate, postgraduate and professional programmes from 1st January to 31<sup>st</sup> May of every year, for the academic year commencing from 1<sup>st</sup> July.
- Students should download the Admission Application Form and the Prospectus (free of cost) from [www.spmvv.ac.in](http://www.spmvv.ac.in)

**Step 1:** International students must fill up the provisional admission application form and submit it, along with the copies of certificates and the application/registration fees to the Dean, International Relations. This should be done well in time so that the student is able to obtain the visa before the due date of admission.

**The enclosures to the application must comprise:**

- Two certified copies of the marks sheet of the qualifying examinations (certified translated version in English)
- Two certified copies of the Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination (Certified translated version in English)
- A copy of the syllabus/curriculum of their respective qualified UG / PG Degree (Certified translated version in English)
- Two copies of the passport of the student.
- A non-refundable Demand Draft towards registration fee drawn in favour of the "Registrar, Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam, Tirupati-2(AP) payable at Tirupati.

**Step 2:** After scrutiny of the application for eligibility, the University will issue a provisional admission letter and the student must obtain a "student visa" endorsed to Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam from Indian Embassy /Consulate.

Admissions cannot be confirmed without a valid visa.

**No objection Certificate:** Students no longer require a No objection Certificate, for joining professional courses.

(This has been withdrawn by the Government of India vide letter No. F.No. 33-17/2002 - U. 4 dated 20th August 2004).

**Security Clearance:** However, all International students wishing to undertake any research work or join a Ph.D. or M.Phil. programmes will have to obtain prior security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs and the approval of Department of Secondary & Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development Government of India and this must be on the Research Visa endorsed to this University.

**Step 3:** After obtaining the Visa endorsed to Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam, the student must apply for final admission, to the Dean, International Relations , Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh, India

**Step 4:** The admission for the International students will be finalized and the seat will be allotted, when the candidate reports in person to the Dean, International Relations and after verification of all the certificates, appropriate visa and the payment of tuition fee in full. If the candidate fails to comply with any of these mandatory documentations, the admission will be cancelled. International students must bring all the original certificates of qualifying examinations while reporting for final admission. The original certificates will be returned to the students immediately after making an endorsement to this effect.

**Step 5:** All the International Students must undergo the medical examination and get the medical fitness certificate. As per government rules, all international students entering India on Student Visa have to undergo test for HIV. All international students will be required to pay medical fees of US \$ 100, It is mandatory for all the international students to take a Health and Travel insurance for the study period and produce the same at the time of admission.

**Step 6:** International students, whose qualifying examination is not in the English medium, must appear at the proficiency test in English as decided by the University.

**Step 7:** Within a week of arrival in India register their names with the Police in the Foreigner Regional Registration Office (FRRO) of the local Police Station.

**Step 8:** International students who are studying for full time courses in any other institution can be given admission into part time / Correspondence courses only if they hold a valid visa for the duration of the part time course. A separate visa is not required. They will have to pay the fees as applicable. Such students must approach the Dean, International

Relations for getting admission into Part-time / Correspondence courses, if they meet the prescribed eligibility qualifications.

## **INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES**

Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam has a welcome pack or guide specifically designed for international students. This is sent by mail once you've been offered a place, and it contains useful information about preparing for studying at SPMVV and what to expect when you arrive.

This guide covers topics such as accommodation options, arranging medical insurance, Tuition fee payments, Visa requirements, [budgeting](#) for living expenses, and advice on what to bring with you. There is also information about the university and how things work here, including important online resources, administrative departments and campus facilities – so that it's all a bit less unknown when you arrive.

### **Pre-arrival support**

To fill these gaps, Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam (SPMVV) has introduced student mentoring scheme that start before arrival. This means future students are matched up with current students, who then communicate, usually via email, in the months leading up to the start of the course.

The idea is to ensure that international students feel welcomed into the student community before they even arrive, and know that there will be at least one friendly face waiting to greet them.

### **Orientation programmes**

The first few weeks of being an international student are likely to be the most obviously overwhelming. There's so much to take in, so many new places and people, and it can take a while to find your feet. Common elements of international student orientation programs include airport pickup, campus tour, sightseeing, social events and activities, and introductory lectures and talks.

Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam (SPMVV) international orientation program lasts for five days. These include finding out about support services and getting used to the Indian

system of teaching and learning, and also laying the foundations of friendships that may last a lifetime.

### **Ongoing support**

The first few days are not the only time international students need support.

The Dean and Associate Dean, International Relations and concerned faculty are available by email, phone or in person to help international students resolve any problems that come up – either themselves, or by directing the student to the most relevant person.

Having this dedicated team is important, because it means international students can always feel confident about where to start if they have a problem, rather than wasting time trying to figure out how or where to get the help they need. The most common problems of international student include; homesickness, culture shock, language difficulties, unfamiliar academic or grading systems, immigration, insurance and health problems. The university's international student advisers have the experience and skills needed to deal with the practical aspects of these issues – but also the emotional side of things.

### **Fun and games**

Not all support services are about fixing problems; many simply aim to ensure all students enjoy their time at university, and have a fulfilling experience. University calendars are packed with events aimed at or organized by international students. Some are specifically intended to promote cultural exchange, and others are just for fun.

## **LIBRARY AND ICT FACILITIES**

The University has a central Library and also Departmental Libraries. Books, e- Books Journals, e- Journals, Periodicals, Reports, Soft copies of various study materials are made available to students during working hours. Free Wi-Fi is made available to all students on campus throughout the day.

## **SPORTS FACILITIES**

The University has a Physical Education Department under which a Gym and Sports facilities are provided. Students interested in sports and games may practice/

work out in the Department of Physical Education during the hours allocated to the students.

## **HEALTH CENTRE**

Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam has a Health Centre located on the Campus, a Medical officer and Para Medical staff cater to the needs of the students. The University also has Hospitals listed for emergency services.

## **CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE RULES**

Under the policy of the university, students enjoy the greatest degree of liberty consistent with high academic standards and orderly conduct. Each student is expected to conduct herself in such a manner as to uphold the good reputation of the University (and her fellow students). At the same time, she should be conscious of her responsibilities imposed by the law and the ideals proclaimed by the University. It is presumed that all students, as members of this Institution of the highest learning understand that maturity, responsibility due regard for rights of others are prerequisites of liberty.

The following rules are to be observed by the students for cherishing the noble cause of the university.

- Each student is required to punctually attend all lectures, practical classes and tutorials held on each working day.
- A student who disturbs the lecture or behaves indecently in a class may be expelled from the class by the teacher. A student so expelled shall be deemed to be absent for the day.
- Every student shall possess the necessary books and other articles required to pursue her studies in the university.
- Every student who borrows books or any other equipment is responsible for their preservation in good condition and in the event of their being lost or damaged. She shall be required to replace them or defray their cost.
- Any student who breaks or damages university's property shall be required to pay the cost of the repair or replacement. In case of willful damage, she shall also be punished in such a manner as the Dean may think fit.
- The student may not be required to pay the cost of any article which he damages if the teacher-in-charge certifies that the breakage is not due to any negligence on the part of the student.

- The student shall submit all communications intended for various purposes only to the Dean through the head of the Department. The Dean will submit them to the higher authorities, if he considers it required.
- Every student shall wear a clean and decent dress approved by the Dean.
- Each student is required to help the administration in keeping the class rooms and premises tidy.
- Smoking by students in the university premises is prohibited.
- Students are prohibited from organizing meetings or entertainment programmes in the campus or collecting money for any purpose without the prior permission of the Dean.
- Consumption of alcohol or other intoxicating drinks, drugs on the campus or entering the campus in a state of intoxication is prohibited and violation of this rule shall attract serious disciplinary action.
- Students shall not hold meetings for criticizing the policies and actions of the university or college authorities. Such meetings shall be deemed to be unlawful and the principal might take such action as she considers necessary to prohibit such meetings or to punish the offenders and in case she considers it necessary / serious she may report the matter to the Vice-Chancellor.
- The Dean may prohibit the students from attending political or such other meetings if she apprehends a breach of peace in the campus. The students who act as volunteers in social services activities taken up in connection with a political meeting should not participate in the proceedings of such meetings.
- The volunteers shall on no account be used for political purposes.
- The Heads of the Departments shall inform, whenever necessary, the Dean, International Relations, about the students who are irregular and do not show any progress in their studies or whose attendance is very poor or whose conduct is dissatisfactory. The names of students who are found incorrigible even after warnings may be removed from the rolls after intimation to the respective embassies. The names of students of the university college who is on strike or found guilty of serious indiscipline shall automatically be removed from the rolls and they shall not ordinarily be readmitted and in no case with retrospective effect.
- Organizing any religious meeting / function / display of religious symbols in a public or open place in the university campus, including hostels, is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this rule shall be construed as an act of indiscipline and disciplinary action will be taken against persons concerned apart from initiating appropriate legal proceedings.
- Students going on strike or in any way guilty of serious breach of discipline, if they are residents of the attached hostels, shall be required to quit the hostels at 12 hours

notice and they shall not ordinarily be readmitted to the privileges of residence in the hostel. In case they are readmitted, they shall pay admission fees.

- Students indulging in any violent activities, voluntarily or under, coercion, direct or indirect, or found pressurizing the college or university authorities to meet their demands will be punished by the university in accordance with the existing rules and regulations.
- The Dean may, on the recommendation of the Head of the Department, or otherwise, inflict the following punishments in the interests of the students or the institution: fine, loss of attendance, loss of term, suspension, expulsion; or such other action as deemed necessary for the maintenance of discipline on the campus.
- Ragging in any form in the university premises is considered to be an offence punishable under law. Ragging in its present form is a deliberate dehumanization of the human values and the culture of living together with a purposeful goal. Ragging both in and outside the campus has been banned. Students involved in any form of ragging will be expelled from the institution by the principal and they will be subject to punishment as per civil law.

#### **DISCLAIMER CLAUSE**

All the International Students may note that in spite of the sincere efforts made by the University to adhere to the Academic Calendar, curriculum, timetable and schedules etc., framed by the University for the academic year concerned, for any dislocation or disturbance caused to the same due to any disturbances natural or manmade (strikes or movements) the University shall not be responsible for any loss, actual or perceived that might be caused to the International Students.
