





Dying - A Memoir

Death is an unavoidable phase in the life of any individual. The process of facing the death differs from one another. People usually become depressed, detached from reality during the process of facing death. Dying makes the people to anticipate death negatively. Standing apart from the pessimistic views, Cory Taylor's "Dying" makes the reader to think about the last phase of life in a positive way. After going through brain surgery, melanoma and many diagnoses, she feels depressed in the initial stage but in the due course of time, there is a huge transition in her towards the good aspects of the situation rather than the bad ones in her last stage. Her reminiscences offer insightful advice on how to deal with difficult circumstances, boost poor self-esteem, and prioritize one's own needs. She endures the same agony as her mother because of her egotistical father. Her relationship with her siblings was never harmonious. Her travelling experiences from her childhood drive her to understand the world better. The language is lucid and her words allow one to grasp her feelings.

Taylor's "Dying" is a provocative memoir, where one can realize the courage and knowledge required to embrace death. Her optimistic view makes the reader to view the bright side of dying. She persuades the reader to accept the dying process. She acknowledges the process of dying and feels it as an opportunity to bid farewell to her family, friends and well-wishers with peace.





Just rise high reach The Sky!


